This activity is an outdoor, field-based experience and will require the Staff to lead between one to six, 3-day or 5-day outdoor trips and complete up to 2 days of pre-trip and up to 2 days of post-trip responsibilities (per trip). There are 2 days of required pre-program training. Leader compensation is as advertised.

Compensation: Lead Staff Stipend - \$125.00 - \$150.00 per day (e.g., \$875 - \$1050.00 for 7 day program [1 day pre-trip; 5 day trip; 1 day post-trip + 2 days required training]). Assistant Staff - \$75 - \$125.00 per day (e.g., \$525.00 - \$875.00 for 7 day program [1 day pre-trip; 5 day trip; 1 day post-trip + 2 days required training]). Lead and Assistant compensation rates are dependent on experience and certifications.

Qualifications:

- Must be a current or former Brock undergraduate or graduate student.
- Demonstrated success and expertise in planning and leading expeditions and teaching outdoor skills with technical expertise (certification preferred) in 1 of the following areas: canoeing, backpacking or top rope rock climbing.
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively with other Staff in coordinating extended field experiences.
- Demonstrated success and expertise in managing risk in a wilderness context.
- Ontario F Class Driver's License (or equivalent) preferred.
- Current Wilderness First Responder (WFR) or equivalent and CPR required for Lead Staff.
- Current Wilderness First Aid (WFA) or equivalent and CPR required for Assistant Staff WFR or Wilderness Advanced First Aid (WAFA) or equivalent preferred.
- Current Bronze Cross swimming certification or Swiftwater or Whitewater Rescue Technician certification required for water based activities.
